

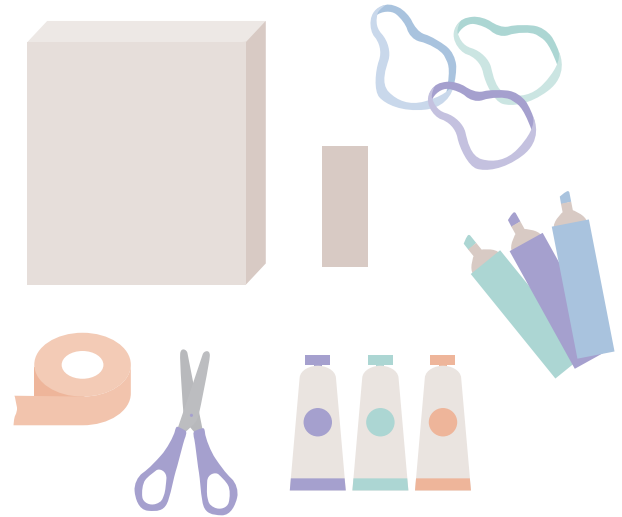

Make your own guitar

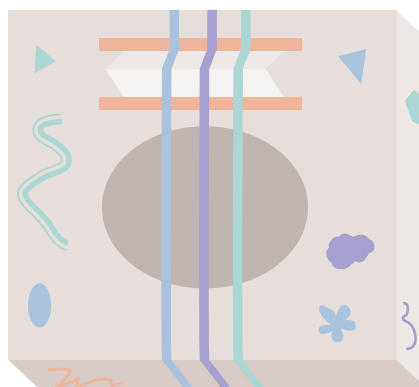
You need:

- A cardboard box such as an empty cereal box
- A small rectangular piece of cardboard
- 3 or more rubber bands
- Sticky tape
- Scissors (use with care and under supervision)
- Paint, textas or stickers for decorating



Instructions:

1. Decorate the outside of your cardboard box with paints, textas or stickers.
2. Take your small rectangular piece of cardboard and fold it in thirds length ways to create a triangle, this will be the bridge of your guitar.
3. Cut a circular hole in the middle of one side of the box.
4. Tape the cardboard bridge next to the hole in the box.
5. Put the rubber bands around the box, so that they go across the hole and bridge.
6. Pluck the rubber bands to make noises.
