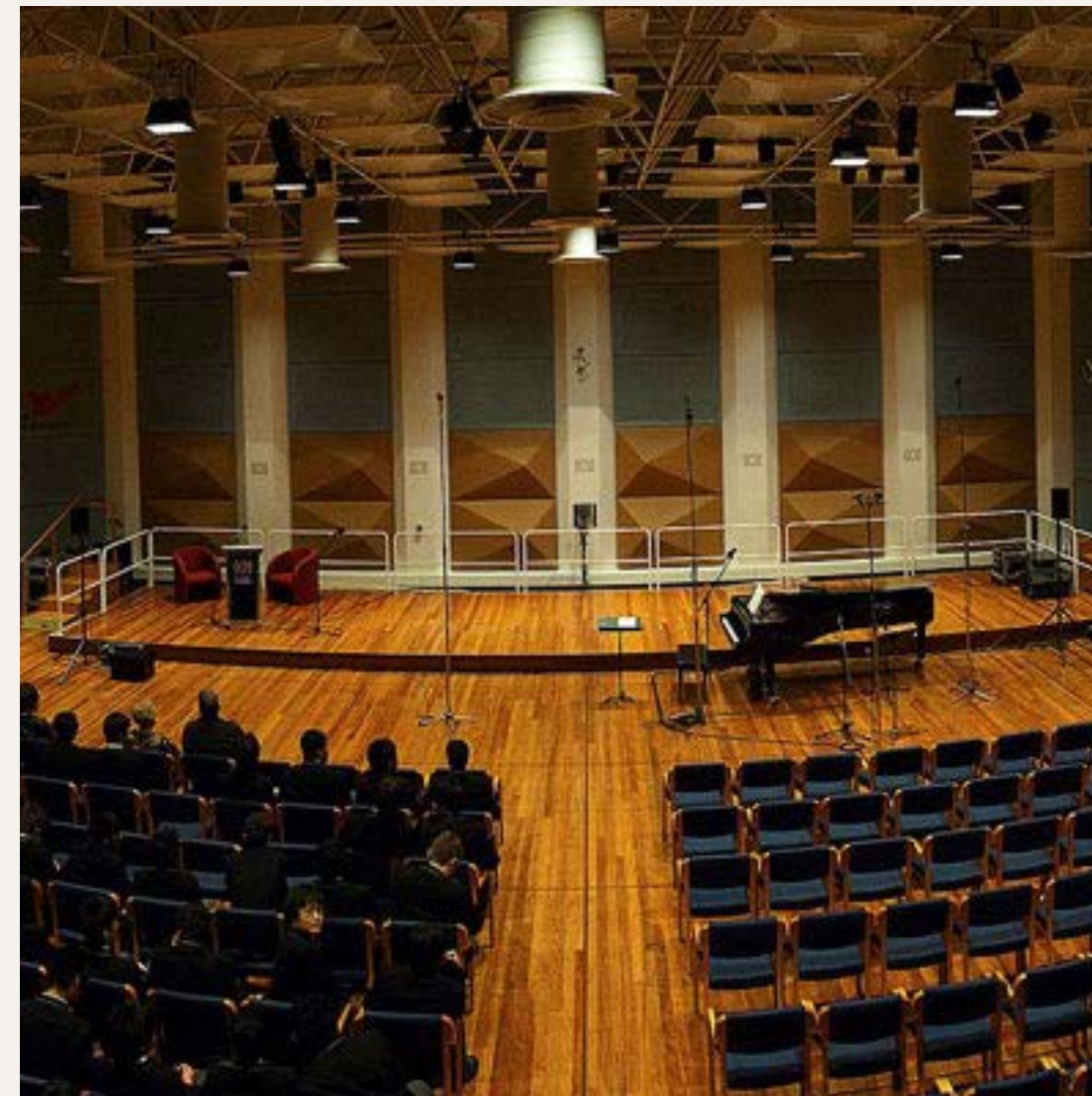
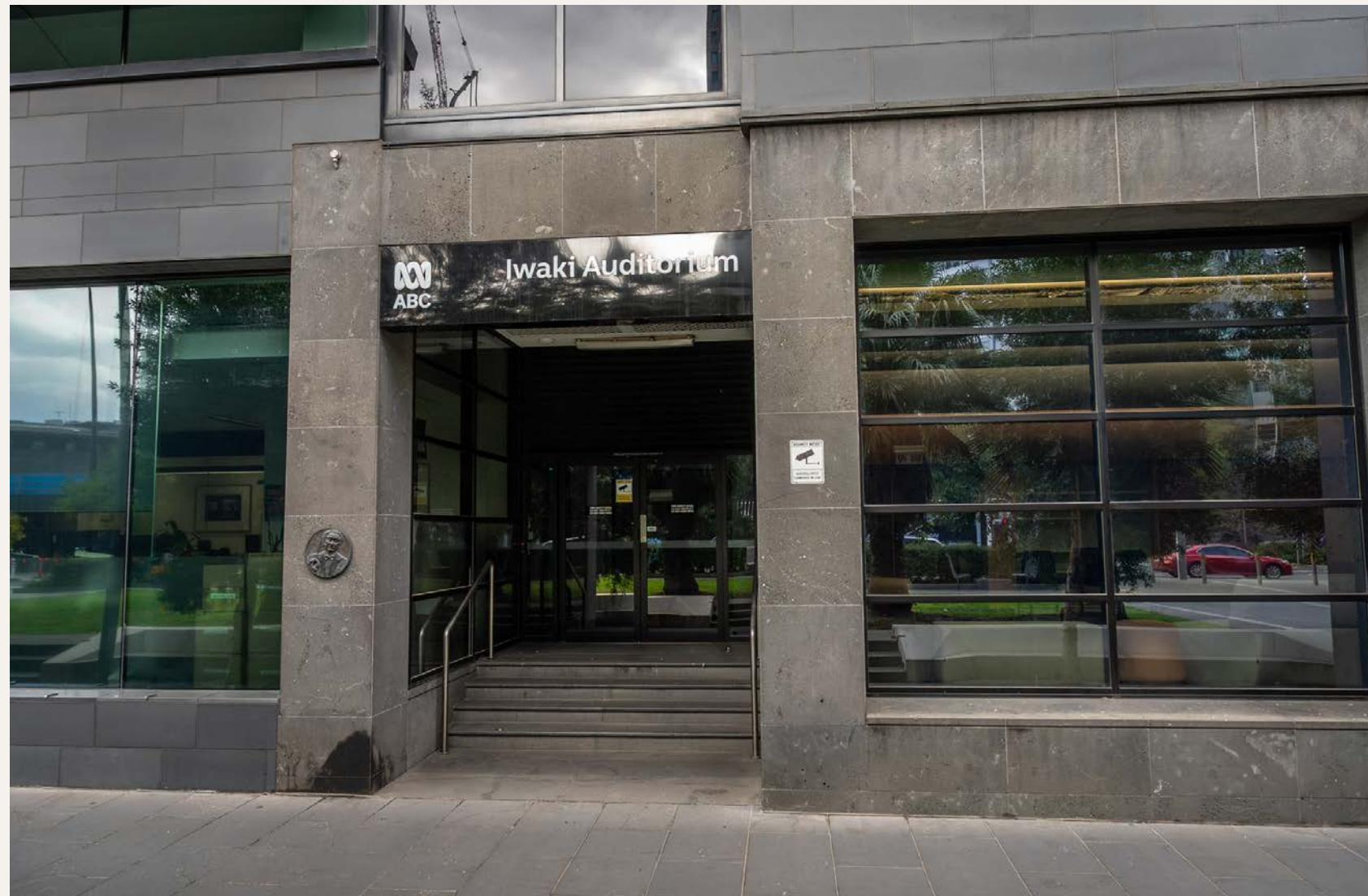

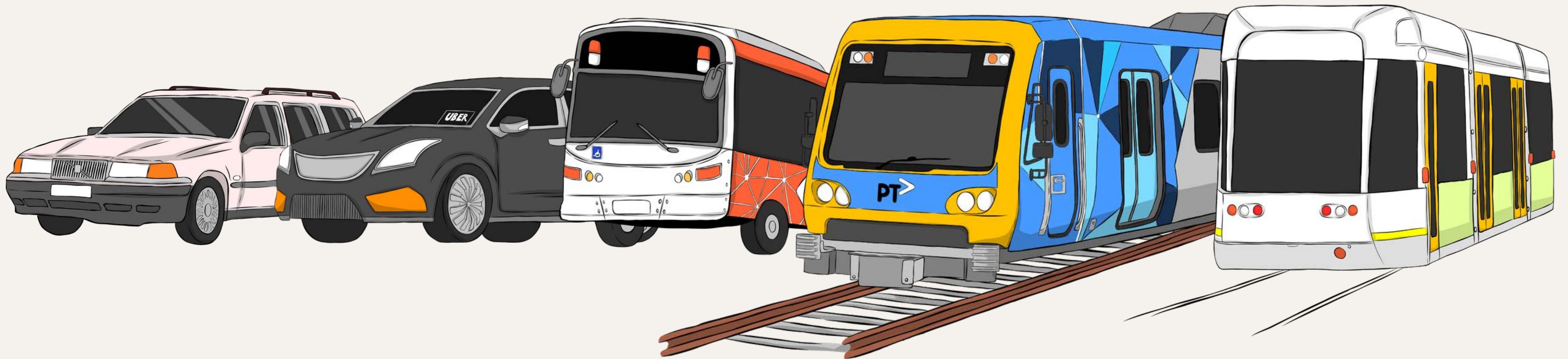

shirt



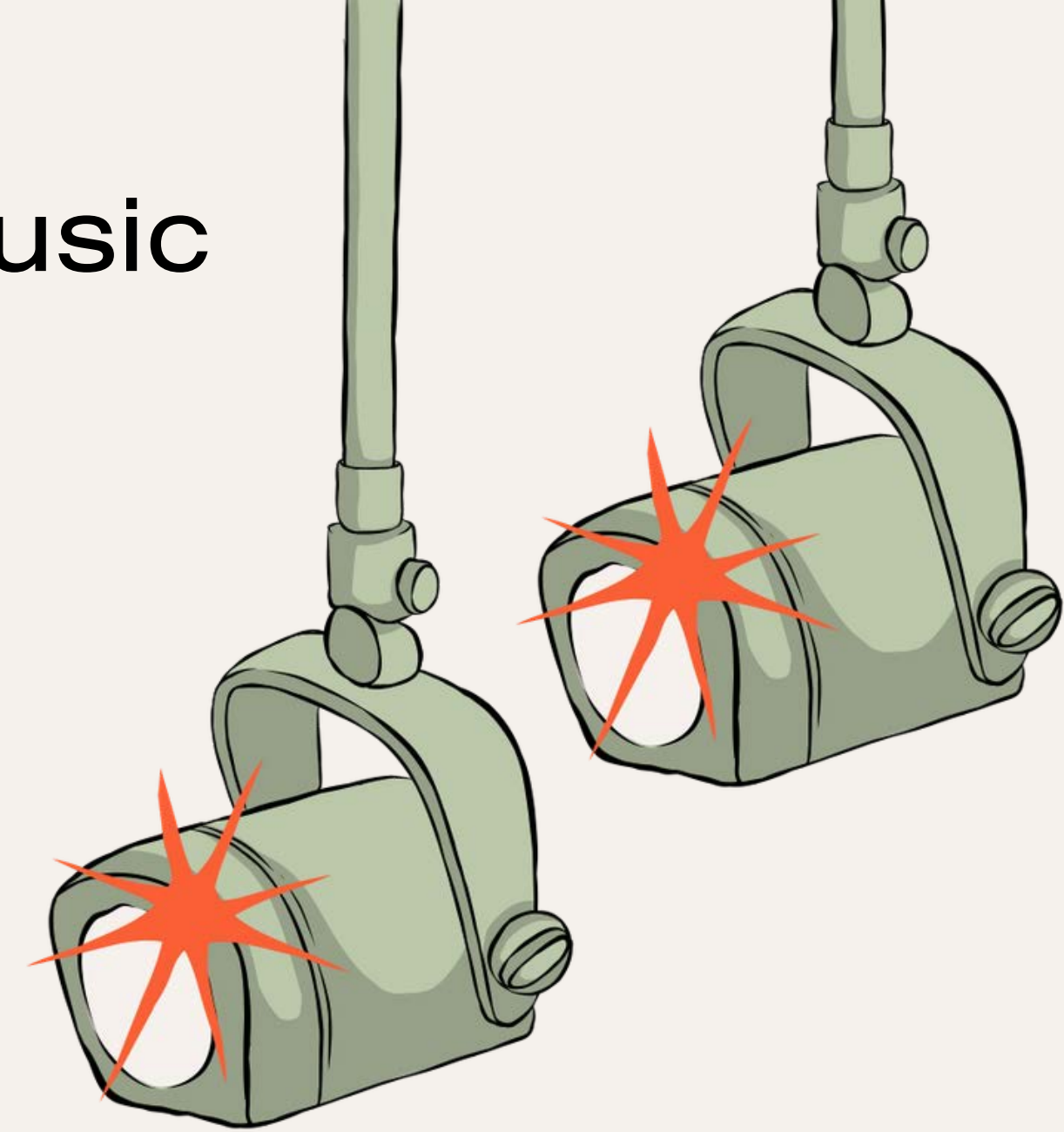

A small bag



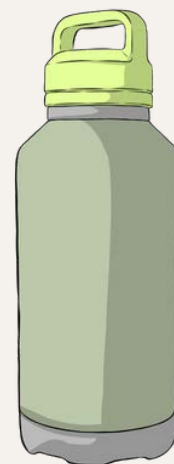
Sunflower lanyard



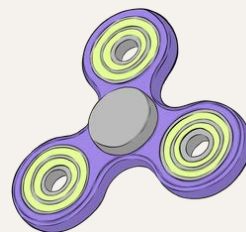
Wallet
