They play different kinds of music.


You can hear them at a concert.

When to come



You need to arrive early.

Like 30 minutes before the concert starts.

That is 11 : 30.

You can go to the toilet.

You can buy food or a drink.

There will be lots of people.

You have a seat in the hall.

The staff will help you find a seat.

Some times you may be late.

This is OK.

You need to wait until the music stops.

The staff will show you where you can sit.

During the concert

People listen to music lots of ways.

You can make noise during the music.

You can use an iPad or a fidget.

Please turn off the sound on your phone and your iPad.



You can move.

Some people dance.

Some people move their hands.



Some people sit still.

You can enjoy the music how you like.



The music might be loud.

You can wear headphones.



You can take a break. It is OK to go outside. You can come back later.



You can clap your hands when the music stops.

You clap your hands to say thank you.

It might be loud when every body claps.

Some people cover their ears.

You can take a photo after the music stops.

After the concert

The lights turn on when the concert ends.

The musicians leave the stage.

It is time to go home.

You can do it again

There are lots of concerts.


You can wear a face mask.
